



THE NEED

There are millions of children in the world who have been orphaned.

This is a global issue. It crosses international borders, racial divides, and economic classes. It impacts children from every walk of life, and something must be done about it.

While the needs of orphans are both varying and complex, there are three key issues that Show Hope seeks to address.



THE FINANCIAL BARRIER

The average cost of adoption can range between \$25,000 and \$50,000. That is outside the financial reach of most families.



THE MEDICAL BARRIER

Many children who have been orphaned live with mild to acute healthcare needs, requiring access to medical and therapeutic intervention



THE KNOWLEDGE BARRIER

Many who have the ability to make a difference in the lives of waiting children do not take action because they are unaware of the need or feel helpless to do anything.



OUR MISSION

To care for orphans by engaging the Church and reducing barriers to adoption

- ADOPTION AID
 - Adoption Aid grants help break down the financial barrier between waiting children and families. These grants have played a vital role in helping more than 6,800 children come home to the love and permanency of a family.
- CARE CENTERS

 For more than 12 years, Show Hope supported a network of therapeutic Care Centers in China, dedicated to caring for orphans with acute medical and special needs. In that time, more than 2,700 children received loving, attentive care. As Show Hope moves forward, it remains committed to the Care Centers Legacy by staying connected to and resourcing the children and families impacted by this work.
- PRE+POST ADOPTION SUPPORT

 Many children who have been adopted have experienced abuse, trauma, neglect, or early attachment injuries. We provide practical teaching and resources to better equip parents and care providers to support their children in the healing journey.
- STUDENT INITIATIVES
 Show Hope's Student Initiatives influence, equip, and mobilize young leaders to carry this life-changing work forward for the sake of waiting children.

FOUNDERS

Mary Beth and Steven Curtis Chapman founded Show Hope in 2003. Their eyes had been opened to the reality of children who have been orphaned, and they knew something had to be done. In the beginning, they dreamed of helping just 100 children come home to loving families. Many years later, Show Hope's Adoption Aid grants have impacted more than 6,800 children, and thousands more across the world have have received care, hope, and healing through the other areas of Show Hope's work.
